

## Deciding What 4-H Poultry Project to Take?

### **Step 1:** Decide what 4-H poultry project to take using the [4-H Family Guide](#).

150CE	Chicken, Exhibition
150CM	Chicken, Market
150CEP	Chicken, Egg Production: Hens and Pullet
150DE	Duck, Exhibition
150DM	Duck, Market
150GE	Goose, Exhibition
150GM	Goose, Market
150TE	Turkey, Exhibition
150TM	Turkey, Market
150H	Helmeted Guinea Fowl



### **Step 2:** Decide if you want to exhibit a 4-H poultry project at the Guernsey County Fair.

If you decide you do want to exhibit at the fair, use the chart below to ensure the 4-H project you have selected aligns with the county fair class you are planning to enter. Two poultry projects, 150GM and 150H, are not eligible for live animal exhibition at the fair. **Project selection is part of the enrollment process which must be complete by April 1!**

4-H Project Number	County Fair Class
150CE or 150CEP	Chicken - large type hen
150CE	Chicken - large type rooster
150CE or 150CEP	Bantam Chicken - small type hen
150CE	Bantam Chicken - large type rooster
150CM*	Chicken - Market Broiler pen <i>(eligible to sell)</i>
150DE	Duck - large female
150DE	Duck - large male
150DE	Duck - Bantam female
150DE	Duck - Bantam male
150DM*	Duck - Market pen <i>(eligible to sell)</i>
150GE	Goose - Breed type
150TE	Turkey - Breed type
150TM	Turkey - Market <i>(eligible to sell)</i>

\* Junior Fair rules require that youth exhibiting 150CM Market Chickens or 150DM Market Ducks must also be enrolled in and exhibit another poultry project (not including 150CM or 150DM).
