

2023 Guernsey County Jr. Fair Livestock Sale

Sale Procedures

Friday, September 15th

Muskingum Livestock, Zanesville is managing the 2023 Guernsey County Jr. Fair Livestock Sale.

Payment options for purchasers:

Option 1 — Pay day of sale by cash, check, or credit card. Credit card purchases will include a 3.5% buyers fee. Settle for your purchases with the sales clerk at the Jr. Fair Sale Office. The Guernsey County Jr. Fair Livestock Sale Committee asks that buyers pay for your purchase the day of the sale. Buyers can pay at the Junior Fair Office for up to one hour after the sale ends!

Option 2 — All bills must be paid to Muskingum Livestock of Zanesville by 45 days after the sale or a finance charge of 5% will be assessed on the balance due. For questions, contact Muskingum Livestock at (740) 452-9984. If you are unable to pay the night of the sale, be sure to **stop by the Jr. Fair Office to double check your invoice and contact information!**

All buyers need a bid number. Previous year sale buyers have received their pre-assigned bid number in the mail. New buyers who did not receive a buyer's number in the mail will need to obtain a bid number by going to the Jr. Fair Sale Office prior to bidding.

“Turn” or “Keep”: At the time of purchase, state to the auctioneer “turn” or “keep”. **This decision cannot be changed.** All animals will have a re-sale bid price. “Turn” indicates the animal goes directly to the designated turn buyer and you pay the difference between the purchase price and the re-sale bid amount. “Keep” indicates you will pay the total purchase price & designate where you want the animal to go (*name of a processor, sale barn, or you want to take the animal home*).

The animal is the property of the buyer as soon as it is sold and may be removed from the fairgrounds at any time after the sale. Exhibitors will care for animals left after the sale until Sunday morning at 6:00 a.m. Halters are to go with the market steers and all feeder calves.

The Guernsey County Junior Fair Sale Committee acts only as an agent in the sale of livestock. No warranty is expressed or implied as to the health, condition, or otherwise of the livestock sold by it.

*In accordance with State of Ohio laws and ODA guidelines, the **Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion animals from the market steer, market lamb, market hog & market goat classes** shall be slaughtered at a meat establishment, either licensed by ODA or granted inspection by the United States Dept. of Agriculture. If one of these animals is turned (purchased for re-sale) it will go to the designated turn buyer, “a licensed livestock facility”, and the buyer will be billed the difference between the purchase price and the pre-sale bid price; if kept (purchased for processing) the animal must go to a fully inspected processor as designated by the Guernsey County Junior Fair Sale Committee where ODA inspectors will examine the carcasses during harvest and processing. **Fully inspected processors from the list on page 2 are indicated with an (*)**. After harvest, animals may be sent to another processor of the buyer's choice for processing.*

All Market Projects sold at the Market Animal Sale, except Poultry, will be either Turned or Kept and there will be **No Give Backs.*
