## Qualifications

1. Age 16 – 19 as of January 1 of current year.
2. Open to all 4-H and FFA members.
3. Members in good standing.
4. There is no limit on the number of candidates from a club.
5. Queens are eligible to run for the Ohio Cattlemen's queen contest.

## Rules and Regulations

1. Applications must be turned into extension office by due date, August 1<sup>st</sup>.
2. Essay consisting of one page on what you have learned from your beef project and how you are going to promote the beef industry.
3. Candidates may only hold this position once.
4. There will be an interview by panel of judges, the middle of August.
5. Must have shown a beef project for 2 consecutive years and be showing this current year.

## Attire for Queen

1. Appropriate attire should be worn throughout the week of the fair.
2. Recommended attire when handing out ribbons:
  - Neat and clean jeans
  - Nice shirt
  - Boots

1. Passing out ribbons at all the beef classes, if possible.
